*Winding Trails to New Heights
and New Outlooks*

Prestonsburg is home to many amazing adventures and even more amazing people. Sugarcamp Mountain Trail, which officially opened to the public in 2017, was designed, built, and is still maintained entirely by volunteers. This multi use trail system designed for hikers, mountain bikers, and horseback was a collaboration between the City of Prestonsburg and Jenny Wiley State Resort Park. The trails start at the top of a reclaimed surface mine and descends down into Jenny Wiley State Resort Park.

There are around 20 miles of trails to explore and navigate. All trails require at least an intermediate level of expertise with some of the mountain biking trails holding black diamond classification. If you are looking for a great family trail, try out the Reclamation Loop or head over to the Overlook, which offers a phenomenal view of Dewey Lake. This month, Sugarcamp will host the Bluegrass Mountain Cup on July 24th & 25th, which is a running and mountain biking national qualifying tournament.
