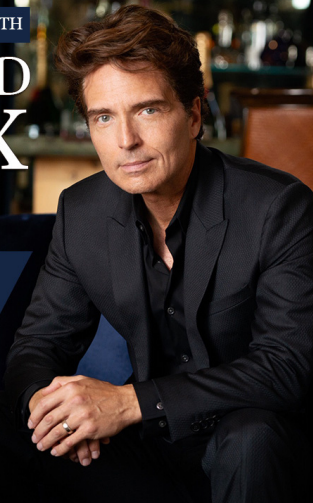

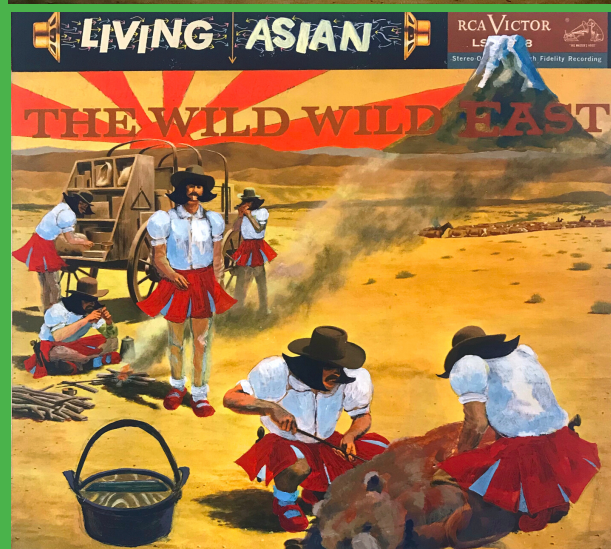

ARTIST SPOTLIGHT

Yoko Nogami

Yoko Nogami was born and raised in Tokyo, Japan. She currently resides in Letcher County and was the Artistic Director and Program Coordinator for Culture of Recovery Program at the Appalachian Artisan Center in Hindman. Prior to that, she was the Visual Arts Department Chair at Pinellas County Center for the Arts in St. Petersburg, Florida. She has also been an adjunct professor at the University of South Florida, University of Tampa, Hillsborough Community College, and the Art Institute of Florida.

Her series "Toko's Banjo World: Almost Famous" will be on exhibit at the Mountain Arts Center this month. The series explores an imaginary world of "what ifs" and incorporates a fictional character named "Toko", who is a hybrid of Yoko and her daughter, Tora. The art is made on album covers and uses a painting technique called "in painting". It requires accurate color matching and seamless flow of objects being inserted into the original work. The art is a collage of her interests including thrifting, old time music, hiking, and encountering bears. This month, she will begin hiking the Appalachian Trail as a thru hiker.
